Additional responsibilities include, but are not limited to: record keeping for training, call response or daily log in Emergency Reporting, as well as preparatory work at the fire station, checking equipment for proper operations and general conditions, performing and assisting with routine maintenance of apparatus, equipment, and the fire station.
